Discussed new Land Information 3 year plan.

Still need funding for:

1. Contractor to finish LiDAR
2. Constant upgrades for parcel mapping
3. Will need orthoimagery, last time was fall of 2015
4. Need to work on road right of ways-this comes up multiple times a day
5. Zoning layers don't match up to parcel mapping

Benchmarks 1 and 2 and 3 are done, but we are behind on benchmark 4 which is PLSS.

Suggestions to designate land records funds in the 3 year plan:

6,300 to Register of Deeds to scan bound tract index books

10,000 for new printer/plotter/scanner for GIS

10,000 for overtime pay for survey crew

9,600 manual maintenance for ESRI software

ESRI GIS Software Additional Costs: 15,000 maintenance for all County ESRI Software per year, or 25,000 for unlimited access to ESRI Software Products for entire County.

Zoning scanning and indexing zoning documents, sanitation permits #1 priority
