Shoreland Restoration Incentive Program

The Sawyer County Shoreland Restoration Incentive Program is designed to provide technical assistance and start-up costs for private property owners beginning a shoreland restoration project. The program is an important tool in meeting the county's Land and Water Resource Management goals to "protect, enhance and restore natural shoreline structure and function" on area lakes and streams.

Funding for the program is limited. Funds will be provided to 10 eligible applicants each year. Emphasis will be placed on planting native species that best suit each site.

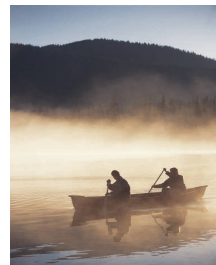

Program Guidelines

- Funding will be provided to ten shoreland property owners on a first-come basis
- Maximum reimbursement for native plants and materials will be prorated at \$200 per 100 feet of restored shoreline
- LWCD staff will make an initial site visit to make recommendations and provide educational materials
- Landowners will be required to submit a draft plan including a drawing that depicts the shoreline, property lines, structures, access corridor and any other pertinent landscape details
- LWCD staff will review and approve the plan and establish funding limit based on the number of linear shoreline feet planned for restoration
- Upon completion of planting, landowners will contact the LWCD for a final site visit and submit receipts prior to reimbursement.
- Time to **enjoy** instead of mowing!
