

1. Gather data from 04/01/07 to 12/31/07, any & all the community events as possible related to alcohol.

- We formatted an one page sheet for this data gathering and it would need to get sent back to sawyer county public health. The form is pretty self-explanatory. The form is attached, feel free to make as many copies as you need and ask others to complete them if they are planning to attend any community events (pow-wows, gatherings, sporting events, election promoting events, community picnics, fairs, etc.)

2. Encourage Families to:

- tell all family members, especially older siblings, that providing alcohol to underage persons is not acceptable.
- secure your personal alcohol supply when adults are not present.
- limit your own alcohol use- they're watching
- support police efforts to break-up underage drinking parties... report parties with teens and alcohol to the police.

3. Encourage Communities and Villages to:

- support police action to break-up underage drinking parties and action against people who provide alcohol to youth.
- Support police age compliance checks.
- Eliminate alcohol sponsorship at community events.
- Ban alcohol paraphernalia from K-12 school events.

4. Encourage businesses to adopt the underage drinking resolution
