Chair Schlender called meeting to order at 12:00 pm.

Certification of Compliance with the open meeting law

Motion by Hoff, 2nd by Johnson, to approve the minutes of the November 10, 2020 meeting. Motion carried

Nick Sayner reported to the Council. JusticePoint received the contract and it is under legal review. Positions have been posted and interviews are scheduled. Should have executed contract by end of day Thursday, December 10. Roles and responsibilities have been determined and funding is approved.

The 5th Street Agreement has been signed by the County and the City of Hayward. The City will start California Avenue in the spring of 2021. County will work with architect on structure plans for second courtroom. Next step is to secure architect and finalize plans.

LCO Tribal Council worked on MOU between LCO and the County using the previous MOU. New MOU includes an increase from \$25,000 to \$50,000 contribution to the Criminal Justice Coordination at the County. LCO may request the tribal judge and magistrate be added to the Council. MOU should be available for approval in January.

Chair Schlender asked for discussion regarding tribal jurisdiction for non-criminal citations issued within the boundaries of the reservation. Motion by McCoy, 2nd by Shuman, to ask for meeting with Tribal Council regarding Tribal jurisdiction. Motion carried
