
RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE TOWN OF LENROOT.
WHEREAS, Sawyer County and the Town of Lenroot have agreed to work together to mutually manage Nelson Lake Park;
WHEREAS, the Town of Lenroot wishes to pursue park improvements such as a pavilion, playground, electricity, new well pump, outhouse, parking area, and picnic area;
WHEREAS, grant assistance will be applied for to fund park improvements;
WHEREAS, these improvements and the general park property will need to be maintained;
WHEREAS, the Town of Lenroot will maintain current and future park improvements as well as manage daily operations of the park to include but not be limited to mowing & plowing;
WHEREAS, the Town of Lenroot will create a park operation plan with the approval and input of Sawyer County;
WHEREAS, Sawyer County will remain the landowner of the County Park and will retain final decision-making approval of park projects and plans;
WHEREAS, the Nelson Lake Dam continues to be maintained by Sawyer County and is not part of this agreement.
THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Sawyer County agrees that the Town of Lenroot will accept the responsibility for the upkeep and maintenance of Nelson Lake Park and approves the Memorandum of Understanding to that effect.







