



47           **WHEREAS**, decreased federal funding would lead to less funding for Sawyer  
48 County's child support agency. This could lead to reductions in child support  
49 enforcement staff and services and reduced child support collections; and  
50

51           **WHEREAS**, new state investments in child support are amplified by a generous  
52 federal match. Every \$1 of state GPR invested in the Child Support Program generates  
53 \$2 in federal matching funds.  
54

55           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Sawyer County Board of  
56 Supervisors respectfully requests that state funding for county child support agencies be  
57 increased by \$1.5 million GPR in each fiscal year of the 2019-21 Wisconsin state  
58 budget, which will generate approximately \$3 million in additional federal funding each  
59 year. This investment will ensure that counties can continue to effectively provide  
60 economic support to our children.

62           **IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED**, that a copy of this resolution be forwarded by the  
63 County Clerk to the Governor of the State of Wisconsin, State Senators and State  
64 Representatives representing Sawyer County, the Secretary of the Wisconsin  
65 Department of Administration, and the Wisconsin Counties Association for  
66 consideration.

68 This Resolution is recommended for adoption by the Sawyer County Board of
