SAWYER COUNTY VISITOR GUIDANCE – SPRING 2020

It is our priority to keep Sawyer County a safe place to both live in and visit. To be successful, we need your help!

1. The following lodging facilities are limited to members of a single household.
(Registered guests only)
 - a. Campsites
 - b. Hotel/Motel Rooms
 - c. Cabins
 - d. Tourist Rooming House (e.g. AirBNB or VRBO)
2. **All guests must be registered.** This means all names of family members along with arrival and departure dates. This is an important step to help with contact tracing should we need to contact close contacts of a COVID-19 positive case.
3. **If you or your family are ill (cough, sore throat, fever) please reschedule your visit for another time.**
4. No visitors, registered guests only.
5. The six (6) foot social distance rule must be followed.
6. All gatherings are prohibited outside of your immediate family. This includes outdoor activities (e.g. bonfires, private family swim beaches).
7. You are encouraged to order over the phone or on-line for any supplies or take-out food that you require.
8. Masks are advised for all people who enter a place of business where it may be difficult to maintain a six (6) foot distance. Many businesses are requiring masking. If you have masks, bring them with you!
9. **Beaches.** In the best interest of public health, safety, & welfare and to prevent people gatherings in a single area, swimming beaches will be closed.
10. **Trails (walking & ATV).** Walking, biking, hiking, and ATV trails will be open if trail conditions allow. Social distancing requirements are to be followed.
11. **Outdoor activity.** Outdoor activities are encouraged. Such activities may include walking, biking, hiking, or running. Individuals may not engage in team or contact sports such as basketball, ultimate frisbee, soccer, or football, as these activities do not comply with social distancing requirements. Playgrounds are closed.
12. **Boat Landings.** Boat landing will remain open. Social distancing requirements must be maintained. It may take longer to get in and out of boat landing in order to maintain social distancing requirements. Keep this in mind when using boat landings.
